Allcorn Cemetery

Latitude 30°13'31", longitude 96°23'03"

An old and poorly-kept cemetery about 3 ½ miles N. of Brenham and about one mile NNE of the confluence of New Year and Tommelson Creeks.

ALLCORN, Mrs. Amy, Consort of T. J. Allcorn, d. December 17, 1852, Age 32 yrs., 4 mos., 20 days.

ALLCORN, Eligah, d. March 21, 1844, Age 73 yrs. Born in the State of Georgia in 1771. Emigrated to Texas with their family of six children in 1821.

ALLCORN, James D., b. in Georgia, February 12, 1797. Emigrated to Texas 1821 with Auston's (sic) Colony where he resided until (sic) death January 29, 1856, Age 59 yrs., four mos., 17 days.

ALLCORN, John H., d. June 7, 1853, Age 51 yrs., 17 days.

ALLCORN, Nancy, (W. of Eligah Allcorn), d. March 30, 1844, Age 71 yrs.

(ALLCORN), Thomas Jefferson, Jr., Son of T. J. Allcorn, Sr., b. November 6, 1847, d. March 23, 1878, Age 31 yrs., 4 mos., 17 days.

CAPLE, Mrs. Mary, d. July 2, 1852, Age 52 yrs.

FRANCES, Mrs. Emely, Consort of C. B. Frances & dau. of J. B. & Lydia Allcorn, b. July 28, 1833, d. September 15, 1856, Age 23 yrs., 1 mo., 18 days.

(GEE), Mrs. Addie, W. of J. B. Gee & dau. of T. J. Allcorn, Sr., b. October 21, 1845, d. January 29, 1868, Age 23 yrs., 3 mos., 8 days.

(GEE), Mrs. Mary., W. of L. G. Gee & dau. of T. J. Allcorn, Sr., b. August 27, 1842, d. March 2, 1876, Age 34 yrs., 7 mos., 7 days.

McNEESE, F. P., b. October 15, 1842, d. September 15, 1867.

McNEESE, Mary A., b. July 10, 1817, d. November 10, 1880.
