## Buster Cemetery

Latitude 30°09'55", longitude 96°28'59".

Two graves and several old trees enclosed by a wrought iron fence on a hillside about two miles west of the Berlin Community. Located along Lange Lake Road about 2 ½ miles SW of US Hwy 290.

Buster, Margaret, b. Apr 25, 1796, d. Mar13, 1879, wife of W. W. Buster.

Buster, W. W., b. Dec 10, 1792, d. Jul 16, 1871, husband of Margaret Buster.

Margaret and W. W. Buster are the proud parents of their famous son, Capt Claudius Buster, who is buried in Prairie Lea Cemetery at Brenham, Texas. The famous Capt. Buster was born in Somerset, Pulaski County, Kentucky, January 21, 1816. He came to Texas with his parents in 1836, held the rank of Captain at the battle of Mier, fought December 25-26, 1842, was captured and kept in prison at the Castle of Perote, City of Mexico until released in 1844. Claudius died December 27, 1889.
