Lehmann, Charlotte (Klatt). B. August 7, 1834 in Liebau, Milowitz, Posen, d. Nov 28, 1918, 2nd wife of Julius Albert Lehmann, dau of Andreas and Anna (Kraus) Klatt.

Lehmann, Emma, b. Dec 2, 1856, d. Jan 10, 1861, dau of Julius A & Wilhelmine (Rosenberg) Lehmann.

Lehmann, Emma Louise, b. Mar 2, 1890, d. Feb 8, 1891, dau of Albert C. & Anna (Hoffmann) Lehmann, grand-dau of Julius & Wilhelmine (Rosenberg) Lehmann.

Lehmann, Hermann August, b. Sep 14, 1834, d. Jul 27, 1866, Pvt. Confederate Army Co C Wouls' Legion Civil War 1862-1865, brother of Julius A. Lehmann, son of Ludwig & Caroline (Zeye) Lehmann.

Lehmann, Julius Albert, b. Sep 26, 1831, d. Sep 29, 1895, Pvt. Confederate States Army, Co C. Wouls' Legion, Civil War 1862-1865, husband of 1st Wilhelmine (Rosenberg); 2nd Charlotte (Klatt) Lehmann, brother of Hermann August. Lehmann, son of Ludwig & Caroline (Zeye)Lehmann.

Lehmann, Wilhelmine (Rosenberg), b. 1834, d. 1861, 1st wife of Julius Albert Lehmann, mother of Emma Lehmann
