Atkinson Cemetery

Chadwick-Hogan Rd

Although it suffered from neglect and vandalism for many years, this cemetery is now endowed and is well kept. Name honors 1857 mayor of Chappell Hill, Jethro Atkinson, whose plantation was nearby. In 1844, date of earliest marked grave, site was owned by Robert Wooding Chappell, for whom city was named.
