Approximately 0.51 acre.

USGS 3096-142

On Hidalgo Bluff between Washington and Independence. Approximately nine graves, earliest about 1850s. A small family plot shaded by live oaks. Exit SH105 at Pickens road about 15 miles from Brenham, then approximately 4 miles to the intersection of Pickens Road, Bluff Road and Puddin Lane. The cemetery is a couple hundred yards northeast from the intersection.
