Rock Island Cemetery

Rock Island

An abandoned and densely overgrown cemetery near the Brazos River at Brown College. Since the following inscriptions were recorded, some of the stones have been bulldozed and destroyed to make room for a Negro graveyard.

(CRAWFORD), Ann F., Second wife of J. F. Crawford, d. in Houston, Tex., 1852.

CRAWFORD, John F., an unusual monument consisting of a square brick pedestal, surmounted by a marble base and shaft. The name appears on one side of the marble base, on another are the words "Horse Shoe," the third side bears the inscription "New Orleans," while upon the fourth is carved the Federal shield and eagle with the motto "E pluribus Unum."

CRAWFORD, John F., (This grave is near the monument described above), b. Rockbridge, Va. 1793, d. Houston, Tex., 1856.

CRAWFORD, Sarah Jane, --Garrett-Chappell--, b. in Mobile, Ala. 1824, d. in Washington, Tex., 1849.

(FELDER), Catherine, Consort of M. M. Felder & daughter. of F. J. & Catherine Felder, b. Brangebury (Orangeburg?), S.C., August 16, 1837, d. August 25, 1869.

FELDER, Jessie, d. November 5, 1865, Age 5 days.

FELDER, Jesse Young, b. in Union Co., S.C., June 30, 1812, d. in Chappell Hill, Tex., February 17, 1870.

FELDER, John B., Son of F. J. & Catherine Felder, d. January 21, 1870, Age 23 yrs., 10 mos.

(FELDER), Marinda R., W. of J. B. Felder & daughter. of T. L. & Emily Burkhead, d. August 9, 1869, Age 32 yrs., 6 mos.

(FELDER), Lorena, Daughter. of M. M. & C. Felder, b. in Navasota, February 18, 1867, d. September 5, 1869.

FELDER, Martha Rowena, b. January 176, 1835, d. October 5, 1870.

FELDER, Miles L., d. May 32, 1861, Age 6 mos. 6 days.

(GREER), Henry, Son of D. D. & M. A. Greer, b. December 15, 1832, d. Accidentally killed by the discharge of a rifle gun, November 28, 1857.
